

Expression of Interest

Interested, competent, qualified and experienced consultant (Organization / Firms) are requested to visit Animal Disease Research Institute, Phulnakhara, Cuttack, Orissa on any working day between 10A.M and 5 P.M. for a consultancy work relating to Establishment of State Referral Laboratory for Disease Control and Strengthening of Training Facilities as per the Good Laboratory Practice (GLP) norm. The basic objective of this Laboratory is to facilitate easy and quick diagnosis of existing, emerging as well as exotic animal diseases having economic and zoonotic importance in view of its control / eradication in the State. Confirmatory diagnosis of animal diseases with the help of modern molecular diagnostic facility will be conducted at this Laboratory. The facility comprises the divisions like Bacteriology, Virology, Pathology, and Parasitology, Surveillance, Analytical, R & D and Seminar-cum-Training Hall with Library. The total plinth area of the proposed laboratory comes to 10,000 sft.

1. After visiting and attending a Technical Committee Meeting at the aforesaid institute, the experts shall have to prepare the detailed floor plan and layout of the proposed laboratory.
 - a) Prepare the Plan design / Engineering related requirements pertaining to Civil work, Clean room, Water connection, Electric connection, Drainage of effluents etc. for the proposed Laboratory, which would comply to all the norms of the GLP.
 - b) Prepare the list of requirement of equipments / Machineries along with the detailed technical specifications as per GLP norm.
 - c) Prepare flow diagrams for movement of staff, material / logistics into and out of the laboratory.
 - d) Submit a detail estimate (component wise) along with Detailed Project Report for the aforesaid purpose.
 - e) Supervise and monitor all the activities starting from the commencement of work till establishment of above Referral Laboratory in all respects within a prescribed time schedule
 - f) Offer technical advice to the departmental technical committee with regard to the proposed work from time to time

- g) Assist the Directorate in procurement of machinery through open tender which includes preparation of tender documents, evaluation of bids & commissioning of equipments.
- h) Prepare required documents for validation of the proposed Laboratory and for obtaining necessary certificate form the competent authority for achieving GLP status.
2. The experts shall submit relevant information regarding their academic qualification, professional experience and experience in handling similar assignment in other institutes and laboratories in the country having similar objectives.
